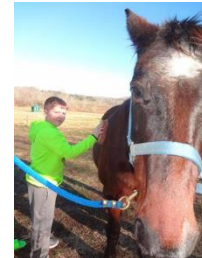
4-H meetings follow the Transylvania County Schools closings. If the schools are closed, the 4-H program is postponed or cancelled.

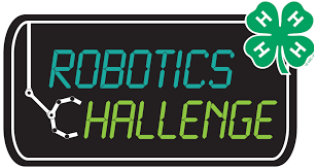


A collaboration between PARI and Transylvania County 4-H - For girls ages 9 to 13. Cost: \$10/session. Register at pari.edu
