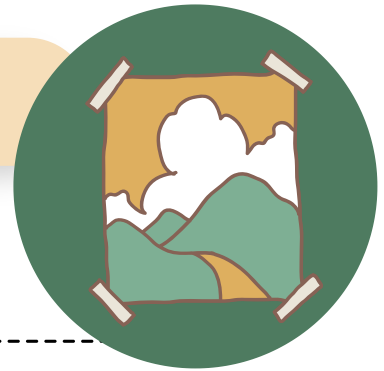
Project Record Books

A scrapbook-style record of what a member has learned and accomplished in a 4-H year. Includes information on project learning experiences, activities, accomplishments, leadership and community services. A competition is held at the county and district level.



Poster Conference

Create a poster that demonstrates mastery of knowledge of the project. Present at a conference style program. Competition at the county level.



Presentation/Demonstration

A speech or demonstration of a skill learned from the project that is presented before a panel of judges. A competition is held at the county and district level.

Mountain State Fair Exhibit

Exhibit at the Mountain State Fair. Works well for projects that don't fit into any other category. For example showing livestock, sewing, woodworking, etc...
